LY, DENIS. Reg. No. 67875. Rank, Private, Royal Field Artillery; killed in action, France, November 17, 1917; born in Ireland.

LY, DONALD. Reg. No. 31850. Rank, Private, Royal Army Medical Corps; killed of wounds, France, April 9, 1917; born in Ireland.

LY, EDWARD. Reg. No. 350. Rank, Private, Connaught Rangers, 5th Battalion; killed in action, Gallipoli, August 15; born St. John's, Sligo.

LY, EDWARD. Reg. No. 7074. Rank, Rifleman, 1st Royal Irish Rifles; killed in action, France, May 9, 1915; born in Ireland.

LY, EDWARD. Reg. No. 7617. Rank, Private, Royal Irish Fusiliers, 1st Battalion; died of wounds, France, October 26, 1914; born Newtownmountkennedy, Co. Wick.

LY, EDWARD. Reg. No. 8440. Rank, Private, 2nd Royal Inniskilling Fusiliers; killed in action, France, November 1914; born Enniskillen, Co. Fermanagh.

LY, EDWARD. Reg. No. 10270. Rank, Private, Royal Irish Regiment, 1st Battalion; killed in action, France, March 15, 1916; born St. Andrew's, Dublin.

LY, EDWARD. Reg. No. 11034. Rank, Lance-Corporal, Irish Guards, 2nd Battalion; killed in action, France, April 12, 1916; born Newcastle West, Co. Limerick.

KELLY, EDWARD. Reg. No. 11191. Rank, Sergeant, The Loyal North Lancashire Regiment, 6th Batt.; died, Mesopotamia, May 28, 1916; born Wicklow.

KELLY, EDWARD. Reg. No. 11364. Rank, Private, Irish Guards, 1st Batt.; killed in action, France, July 29, 1917; born Lurgan, Co. Armagh.

KELLY, EDWARD. Reg. No. 17001. Rank, Private, King's Own Scottish Borderers, 8th Batt.; killed in action, France, January 27, 1916; born Comerstown, Co. Westmeath.

KELLY, EDWARD. Reg. No. 19939. Rank, Private, Royal Irish Fusiliers, 7/8th Batt.; died of wounds, France, August 22, 1917; born Leitrim; age 24.

KELLY, EDWARD. Reg. No. 20659. Rank, Sergeant, Royal Inniskilling Fusiliers, 8th Batt.; died of wounds, France, April 27, 1916; born Whitehouse, Co. Antrim.

KELLY, EDWARD. Reg. No. 68320. Rank, Sergeant, Cheshire Regiment, 1st Batt. (formerly Duke of Cornwall's Light Infantry); killed in action, France, October 23, 1918; born Lisburn, Co. Down.

KELLY, FELIX RUDDY. H.M.S. "Queen Mary"; killed in action, May 31, 1916.

KELLY, FRANCIS. Reg. No. 1700. Rank, Leading Seaman, Royal Navy, SS. "Waverley"; died, December 20, 1917; born Ireland; age 37.
